Taste: Clean initial mouthfeel, with a surge of leather, liquorice and oak

Finish: Demerera sugar with dry vanilla and toffee. ended with a slow rise of spice

Sazerac 18 Year Old Rye Whisky

This is the only pure rye whisky available in South Africa. Sazerac is not only rated as the best, but also the oldest rye whisky in the world. Although it resembles bourbon in Character, it has an identity all its own.

George T Stagg

Rated "World Whisky of the Year" 2004 and 2005, Stagg is without a shadow of a doubt the most phenomenal bourbon ever to be produced. Only 600 bottles are produced yearly, making it very rare. Stagg won the top accolade at the 2003 IWSC competition for bourbon.

With a whisky like this, tasting notes are pointless. look for it and you will find it. Bottled at cask strength, it is recommended that this whisky is consumed neat, in a wine glass at body temperature. Whatever you do, take your time. You will want to savour every moment. 97points Jim Murray.



William Larue Weller

The Antique collection wouldn't be complete without a special bottling of the wheat recipe WL Weller. For a further touch of uniqueness this whiskey is bottled at cask strength from hand selected barrels. The age of this whisky is different from barrel to barrel, ensuring that the whisky is picked at optimal maturity.

The newest whisky in the Compass Box stable and by far the most unique, Spice Tree is a vatted malt blended together from 4 top highland distilleries that have undergone secondary aging in barrels that contain French Oak staves. The idea behind this whisky was to explore how important the type and quality of oak used for aging is and how it will affect the whisky.

Taste: A rich nose with strong notes of cloves, nutmeg and sweet stewed fruits. The palate is soft, sweet, deep and rich with a malt whisky fruitiness embellished by deep spice. Very long finish



Compass Box Peat Monster

A monster it is. The new favourite of peat whisky lovers, Peat monster is a vatted malt, blended from one of Islay's most prominent distilleries with a well known highland distillery. The highland whisky in Peat Monster makes it more accessible to peat novices while the Islay stays true to its reputation. Peat Monster is aged between 12 and 17 years. All Compass Box Whiskies are non chill filtered and contain no colouring. 2005 Gold Medal, Best in Class IWSC

Taste: Big peaty, smoky nose, like bacon sizzling in a pan. The nose is balanced by rich, malty and smoky components, with elegant sweetness coming from the highland whisky. Finish lasts forever

The first bottling from Compass Box, Hedonism is unique in that it is a Vatted Grain whisky. Grain whisky is mostly used in as a binding and filling whisky for blends, and its true potential has never been explored, until now that is. Hedonism is soft, elegant, complex and extremely lip smacking. This whisky suits all tastes and is perfect for people wanting to try whisky for the first time.
